### DESCRIPTION

Plastic Wood is a fast-setting solvent based interior wood filling cement suitable for all types of woodwork.

### SIZES AVAILABLE

Plastic Wood is available in a 50g tube and also 230g and 460g tins, tan (maple) in colour only.

### USES

Selleys Plastic Wood is ideal for filling holes, dents and chips in natural wood.

### TECHNICAL FEATURES

- Fast setting.
- Can be sanded, nailed, planed, painted or lacquered.
- Sets to a hard finish.
- Can be treated in all respects as real wood by staining, varnishing or painting.

### TECHNICAL DETAILS

<b>Appearance:</b>	Maple coloured paste.
<b>Viscosity:</b>	2500P (at 25 °C).
<b>Shear Strength:</b>	1000kPa (on marine coachwood).

### HOW TO USE

Surface must be clean, dry and free from loose material. Apply with a putty knife. Slightly overfill deep holes to allow for sanding. Do not fill more than 6mm in each application. Allow to dry before sanding, staining or painting. Replace lid firmly after use and store in a cool place.

### Clean Up:

Putty knife can be cleaned with Methylated Spirits.

### LIMITATIONS

Plastic Wood is not flexible. Use Selleys No More Gaps for filling gaps between surfaces where structural movement occurs. Not suitable for exterior use.
